Information Systems Technology Certificate (IST): Includes computer and telecommunications systems, software engineering, networked and distributed applications, database management systems, and decision support systems.

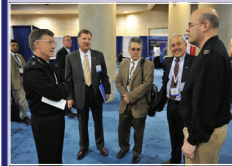
