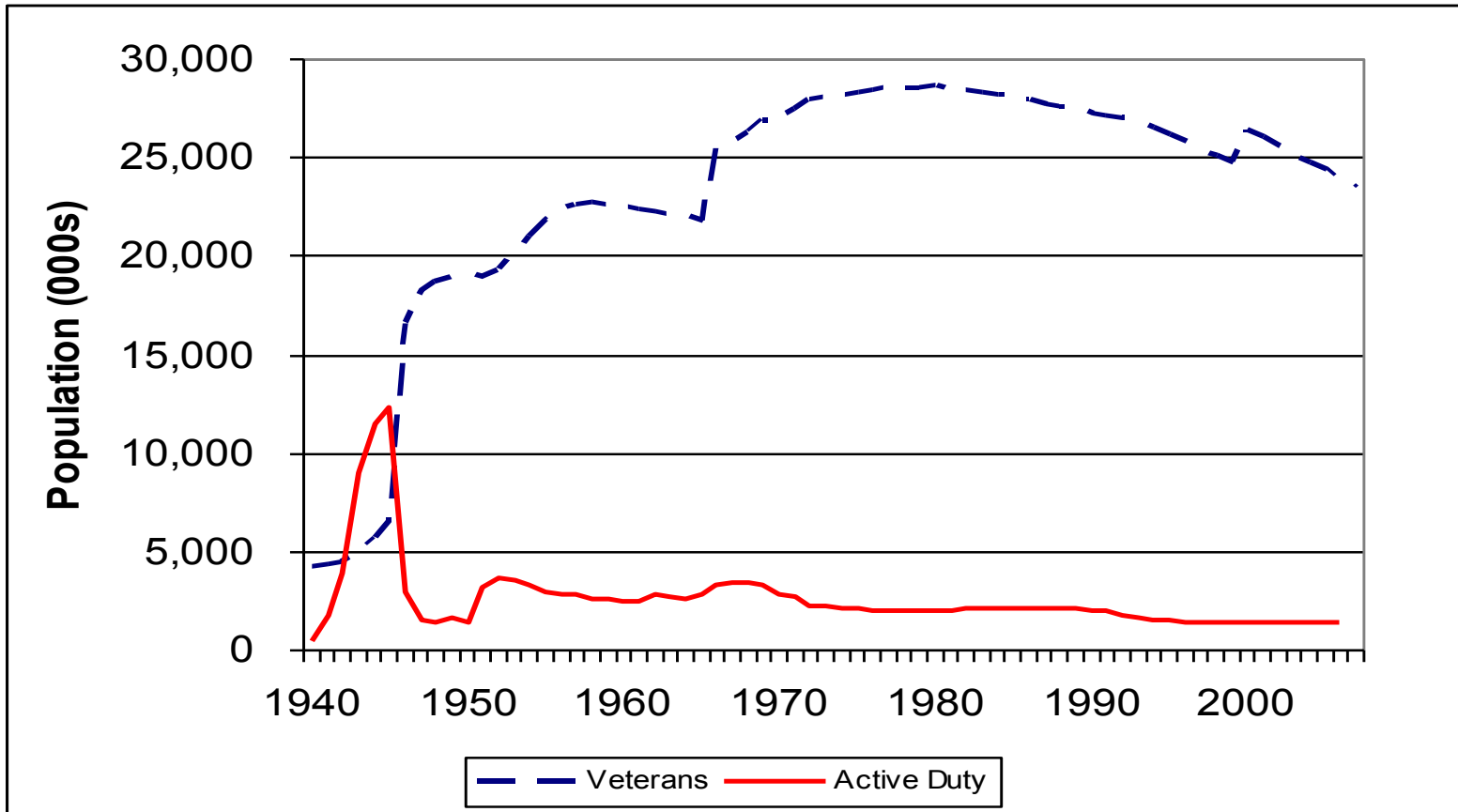

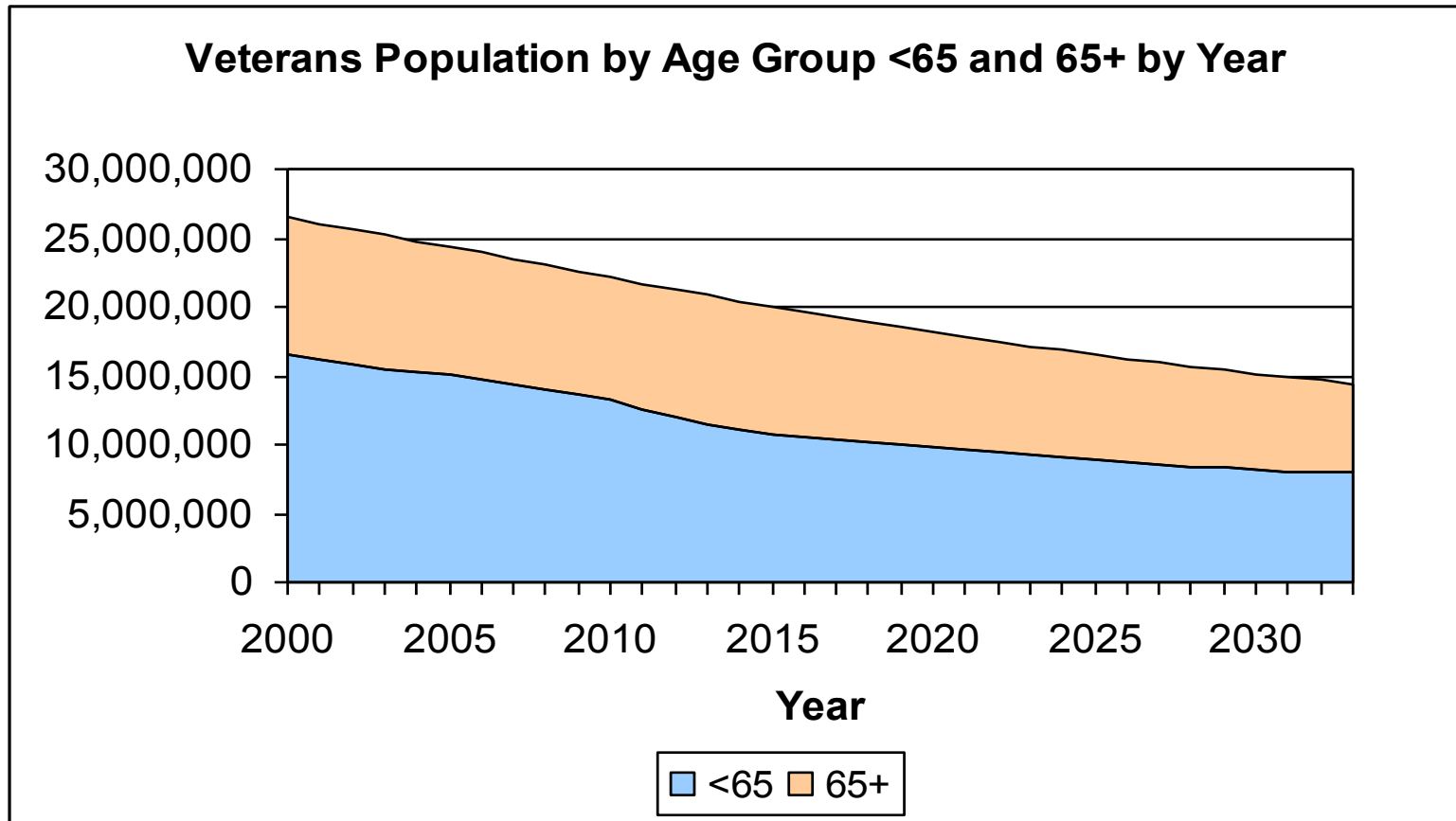
EXHIBIT 1 Active Duty and Veteran Populations, 1940 – 2006

Note: The increase in the veteran population in 2000 is an artifact of the decennial census, which identified more veterans than had been projected from the 1990 census. Some experts believe that increased life expectancy was the reason for this difference between projections and census in 2000.
