The purpose of the instruction is to establish policies and procedures regarding equal opportunity in the Off-Base Housing Program. - **4TH OF JULY - SAFETY NOTICE.** In order to head off a repeat from last year during the Monterey Bay 4th of July fireworks display - where individuals (including children) were viewing fireworks from the 6th, 7th & 8th decks on top of Spanagel Hall, Bldg 232, these areas have been designated off limits during this year's fireworks display. Signs will be posted at Spanagel Hall, Bldg 232 entrances. Also, viewing fireworks from any building rooftop or from outside fire escapes at NPS is also prohibited. NSAMB Base Police will be patrolling to monitor the situation.

- **NPS and NSAMB WILL HOST A FREE CONCERT** and open house on Sunday, July 6, from 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The theme of the concert will be: A Americana: Celebrating America, @ featuring the world premiere of the East of Eden Symphony composed by Robert Nelson. The formal performance starts at 2 p.m. Guests may tour the historic building, once the centerpiece for Sam Morse's 20,000-acre Asports empire, @ watch rare historical video provided by TCI Cable and The Monterey Show, and see the award-winning video, A Time Captured in Paintings, @ which chronicles the artistic achievements of early 20th Century impressionists from the Monterey Peninsula. - **VICTORY OVER TRASH DAY.** To enhance the overall appearance of the NPS campus and beautify the base, a second annual 'Victory Over Trash Day' has been declared by the Superintendent. A base map is posted at the NPS/NSAMB quarterdeck showing the various zones. There will be a 'Best Pick-Up Stick' contest to find the device which demonstrates the most innovative method to conduct trash pickup operations, with prizes (provided by your Navy Exchange) to be awarded to the best three devices. Participation by all hands, while on a purely voluntary basis, is strongly encouraged. Pick-up sticks, trash bags and other equipment will be provided.
