
Back-to-back CCMR METs in Bogota, Colombia

August 30, 2014

CCMR conducted two seminars in Bogota, Colombia from August 20th to 29th. During the first week, Professor Erik Dahl (from the Naval Postgraduate School's National Security Affairs Department), Lecturer Cristiana Matei from CCMR, and Captain Tim Doorey, USN (Ret.) also from CCMR conducted a three-day seminar on "Intelligence Fusion Centers." Approximately 34 Colombian intelligence officers from all services and geographic areas attended the seminar. Following the six CCMR presentations, the participants conducted an exercise on what they thought a national-level intelligence fusion center should look like including location, representation, manning, customers, etc.

During the second week, CAPT Doorey, USSOUTHCOM cyber experts, Colombian instructors from the National Police, the National War College (ESDEGUE), and a judge who was an expert on Colombia's cyber laws conducted a week-long seminar on "Cyber Threats to National Security" to approximately ninety senior military officials (Colonels and Navy Captains selected for general and admiral), civilian officials from various ministries and students from the University of Los Andes. Following a series of presentations, the senior participants were divided into three working groups and conducted two exercises: a cyber risk assessment and developing a cyber security strategy.

Both of the CCMR METs were very well received by the Colombian participants.
