



- An Oral/Dental Exam must be completed during the school year but is not required at the time of enrollment.

#### **SB 277-CA School Immunization**

Requirements - Almost all California school children are required to be fully vaccinated in order to attend public or private school, regardless of their parents' personal or religious beliefs. SB 277 is being phased in and will go into full effect by 7/1.

**6-12 Grade Students** - It is not too early to get your 6th grader ready for the school year. Students entering or advancing to grades 7-12, or entering school in California for the 1st time must provide proof of immunization with a pertussis (whooping cough) vaccine booster called tetanus toxoid, reduced diphtheria toxoid and accellur pertussis vaccine-TDAP. Students will not be allowed to begin the school year until proof of immunizations or exemptions are presented to their school site. See Education Code 48210-48216

**Homeschooling in Monterey?** Register with a public school, private school, public charter school, correspondence course, virtual academy, or file an R-4 affidavit with

the State. Contact your SLO for assistance.






