RESUME OF JAMES SHERMAN BLANDIN

James S. Blandin was born in Great Lakes, Illinois on 23 November 1946. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from the University of California at Santa Barbara in 1968. He entered the Graduate School of Management and Business at the University of Oregon in 1971 and received the degrees Master of Business Administration in 1972 and Doctor of Philosophy in 1974. His major academic fields of interest include organization theory, labor economics, and applied statistics.

Prior to graduate work, he was employed as an assistant program manager at Raytheon Company in 1968 and as a systems analyst at Litton Industries in 1969. From 1969 to 1971, he served on active duty in the U. S. Navy.

In June 1974, he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School, where he served as Assistant Professor (1974-79), Associate Professor (1979-1987), and Professor (1987 to date). He was appointed Executive Director of the Defense Resources Management Institute, Naval Postgraduate School in 1982 and served in that position until 1992. Mr. Blandin has been a consultant to the DoD Comptroller, The Center for Naval Analysis, The Defense Security Assistance Agency, and the Joint Chiefs of Staff (J5).

His research has appeared in a variety of books and journals including, *The Journal of Business Research*, *Academy of Management Journal*, *IEEE Transactions on Engineering Management*, *The Defense Management Journal*, *Armed Forces and Society*, *Defense Economics*, and *Armed Forces Comptroller*.

Mr. Blandin assumed his current duties as President, Defense Business Management University in December 1992 and, in that capacity, reports to the DoD Comptroller.
