RESUME OF ROBERT EDWARD BOYNTON

Robert E. Boynton was born in Lakeville, Minnesota, in 1929. He served four and a half years in the U.S. Navy as an Electronics Technician after graduation from high school. He received a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the University of Minnesota in 1956 and a Master of Arts in Industrial Relations in 1962. During his college studies he worked as a communications technician, radio and television engineer, and engineering manager.

In 1962 he enrolled as a graduate student at Stanford University and was awarded the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in 1968. His dissertation relating management theory and policy to the organizational success of a manager was under the direction of Dr. Dale Yoder. He has held teaching and research positions at Stanford, San Jose State University, Stanford Research Institute, Varian Associates, Arizona State University, Monterey Institute of International Studies, and Golden Gate University.

Dr. Boynton joined the faculty of the Defense Resources Management Institute at the Naval Postgraduate School in June 1970. His primary research interests are management theory, managerial and organizational policy, human resource management, and manager development. He has consulted and conducted research for the Navy, Air Force and private organizations.

He is a member of the Academy of Management, Society for Human Resource Management, the Industrial Relations Research Association, the American Society for Public Administration, the Labor Arbitration panels of the American Arbitration Association and the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service. He is certified as a Senior Professional in Human Resources.
