## RESUME OF STEVEN RICHARD BAKER

Steven R. Baker was born in Los Angeles, California, in 1953. He received the B.S. (Summa Cum Laude, Phi Beta Kappa, 1975), M.S. (1977), and Ph.D. (1986) degrees in physics from the University of California at Los Angeles. His Ph. D. dissertation research was on the acoustic properties of superfluid helium contained in a porous solid. While a graduate student he was a Chancellor's Intern Fellow of the University of California and a Leo P. Delsasso Memorial Fellow of the Physics Department.



Since 1985 he has been at the Naval Postgraduate School, where he is an Assistant Professor of Physics. His current research interests include the acoustic properties of fluid-filled porous media and electroacoustic transduction.

Professor Baker is a member of the American Physical Society, the Acoustical Society of America, the American Geophysical Union, the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, the Audio Engineering Society, and Sigma Xi.
