RESUME OF WILLIAM AYERS CAMPBELL

William A. Campbell was born in Tuskegee Institute, Alabama, in 1917. He attended Tuskegee Institute College where he received the degree of Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in 1937.

Following employment at Tuskegee Institute, he entered the United States Army Air Corps as an aviation cadet in 1942.

In 1949 he enrolled in the University of Pittsburgh Graduate School where he received a Master's degree in Industrial Management in 1950.

Assignments subsequent to 1950 were Director of Management Analysis, Far East Air Forces, Japan; Chief, Management Information Division, Headquarters United States Air Force; and Comptroller, 14th Aerospace Force, Colorado. He retired from the United States Air Force on 1 October 1970 with the rank of Colonel.

In October 1970 he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, where he is teaching in the Navy Management Systems Center.
