## RESUME OF EDWIN JOHN DORAN

Edwin J. Doran was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in 1933. He attended the University of Pennsylvania where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics in 1955. Active duty followed in the U. S. Marine Corps from which he retired as a Lieutenant Colonel on 1 May 1975.

Graduate study at the Naval Postgraduate School resulted in a Master of Science degree in 1968.

Additional graduate study followed at the University of Santa Clara where he received the degree of Master of Business Education in 1972. He received the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration from the University of Santa Clara in 1977.



He joined the military faculty of the Defense Resources Management Education Center at the Naval Postgraduate School in 1969 and taught in the Defense Management Systems Courses until 1973.

While on active duty he served in a variety of military assignments ranging from systems analyst to artillery officer in Vietnam. His most recent assignment was Chief of Test Division, Marine Corps Tactical Systems Support Activity, Camp Pendleton, California.

He joined the civilian faculty of the Defense Resources Management Education Center in May 1975 as an Associate Professor of Management.
