RESUME OF LTCOL STEVEN GROHSMEYER, USMC

LTCOL Grohsmeyer was born June 8, 1951 in Oak Park, Illinois and graduated from Illinois Benedictine College in 1973 with a B.S. in Physics and Mathematics.

After commissioning, he attended Basic School in Quantico, VA, and Navy Flight Training at Pensacola, becoming a Naval Aviator in June 1975.

From 1975 - 1980, LTCOL Grohsmeyer flew CH-53 helicopters for MAG-16, Tustin, CA and MAG-36, Okinawa, Japan, making two unit deployments. He attended the WTI course in Yuma, Arizona in 1977.

After return to CONUS, he was Air Officer for 1st Bn, 7th Marines at Camp Pendleton, CA from March 1980 - May 1981, at which time he was selected to attend U. S. Naval Test Pilot School.

From June 1982 to June 1984, LTCOL Grohsmeyer served as a test pilot at the Rotary Wing Aircraft Test Directorate, NATC Patuxent River. While there he conducted aerial refueling tests, air resonance tests with external loads, icing tests, stability and control testing and envelope expansion, and performance evaluations of the CH-53E aircraft.

He was then assigned to the USNTPS instructor staff where he taught fixed-wing and helicopter stability and control and performance from June 1984 to August 1985.

A tour at MAWTS-1 followed, where LTCOL Grohsmeyer served as the Assault Support Specialist in the Aviation Development and Tactics Evaluation Branch from Sept. 1985 to May 1988.

LTCOL Grohsmeyer attended U. S. Naval Postgraduate School from July 1988 to Sept. 1990 earning his M. S. in Aeronautical Engineering and an Aeronautical Engineer Degree.

From Oct. 1990 to Aug. 1991 LTCOL Grohsmeyer was assigned to 1st MAW, Okinawa, Japan as Wing Operations Officer. He reported to Aviation Safety Programs in September 1991 as Aerodynamics Instructor.

LTCOL Grohsmeyer is married to the former Janeen Kelley and has one son, Ryan.
