RESUME OF FENN CLARK HORTON

Fenn Horton was born in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, on 24 January 1926. He received the Bachelor of Arts degree in 1950 from the State University of Iowa, where he majored in journalism and marketing.

In 1960 he entered graduate studies in economics at Claremont Graduate School. He received the Ph.D. degree in 1967. His thesis topic was, "The Investment Decision: A Mexican Study."

During the 1950's he was employed by the Meredith Publishing Company, the General Electric Company, and Litton Industries, where he served on the corporate staff in the management of divisional advertising and public relations operations.

His academic employment has included faculty positions at San Bernardino Valley College, the University of Southern California, Claremont Graduate School, and The American University in Cairo, Egypt.

In July 1964 he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, where he is teaching in the Department of Administrative Sciences.

He is a member of the American Economics Association and the Western Economic Association.
