RESUME OF ROBERT RUSSELL JUDSON

Robert Judson was born in Kansas City, Missouri, on 4 December 1928. He attended the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana, where he majored in government and minored in history. He received the degree of Bachelor of Arts in June 1951.

Graduate study followed at the University of Illinois where he received the degree of Master of Science in June 1955. His research in the field of international relations was under the direction of Professor Alfred E. Bestor. The Doctor of Philosophy program in International Relations was pursued at American University in Washington, D. C., with course work completed in June 1966.



Since 1955 he has been working in the field of Federal procurement and has had assignments which included: U. S. Navy, Bureau of Ships, Negotiator, 1955-60; Collins Radio Company, Manager, Corporate Contract Administration, 1960-66; IBM, Federal Systems Division, Manager, Contracts Policy and Planning, 1966-70; Commission on Government Procurement, Deputy Director, 1970-73.

In September 1973 he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, where he is teaching in the Department of Administrative Sciences. In addition, he is a consultant to the Subcommittee on Federal Procurement of the Senate Government Operations Committee.

He is a member of the National Contract Management Association and Phi Eta Sigma.
