RESUME OF MILTON D. KITE

Milton D. "David" Kite was born in Manhattan, Kansas in April, 1952. After graduating with a B.A. in Environmental Science from the University of Kansas in 1974, he was commissioned through the Navy ROTC program. He received a M.S. in Engineering Acoustics from the Naval Postgraduate School in 1988.



He served in the Weapons department of both Poseidon and Trident class missile submarines and as Engineering Officer on a diesel submarine. His shore tours include Tactical Support Officer at a submarine group and as the program coordinator and contract officer's technical representative for a high priority classified research program.
