RESUME OF RAMAKRISHNA JANASWAMY

Ramakrishna Janaswamy was born in Kollur, Andhra Pradesh, India, on September 17, 1958. He received the B. Tech degree (and was awarded a Gold Medal for academic excellence) from the Regional Engineering College, Warangal, India, in 1981, the M. Tech degree from the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, India, in 1983, and the Ph.D. degree from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst, in 1986, all in electrical engineering.



From 1986 to 1987, he was an Assistant Professor of Electrical Engineering at Wilkes College, Wilkes Barre, Pennsylvania. Since the September of 1987, he has been an Assistant Professor in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California.

His teaching interests are in the general areas of Electromagnetics and Radar. His current research interests include analysis and design of millimeter wave antennas, non-linear electromagnetics, and electromagnetic scattering. He is a member of the IEEE Antennas and Propagation, Microwave Theory and Techniques, and the Electromagnetic Compatibility Societies, the American Geophysical Union, and the Electromagnetics Society.
