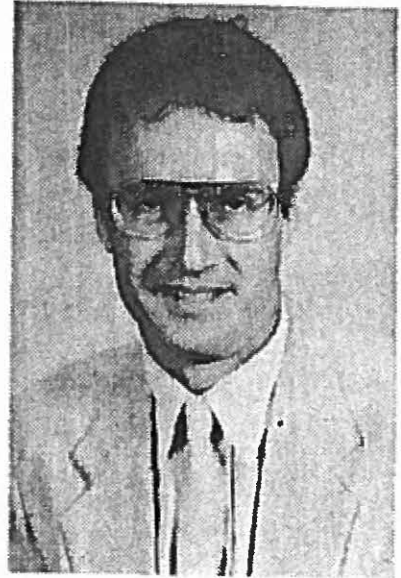

## RESUME OF FRANCOIS MELESE

Francois Melese was born in Versailles, France, on 6 July 1955. He graduated from the University of California at Berkeley and received the degree Bachelor of Science in Economics in 1977. He also attended the University of British Columbia, Canada where he earned an M.A. in Economics in 1979. Additional graduate study at the University of Louvain, Belgium resulted in the Doctor of Philosophy in 1982. His dissertation concerned the optimal management of nonrenewable energy resources: problems of entry and taxation.



He was a Research Fellow at the Institut de Recherches Economiques et Sociale (IRES), University of Louvain, Belgium; and Assistant Professor of Economics at Auburn University.

In June, 1987 he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School as an Associate Professor at the Defense Resources Management Education Center. His current research is concerned with stochastic control models, cost-reducing developments in defense systems production, energy issues, international trade relations and industrial organization.

He is a member of the American Economic Association, Southern Economic Association, European Economic Association, and the Research Society of American Scientists--Sigma Xi.

His published research has appeared in the Quarterly Journal of Economics, the Southern Economic Journal, Applied Economics, Energy Economics, the Atlantic Economic Journal, and Recherches Economiques de Louvain
