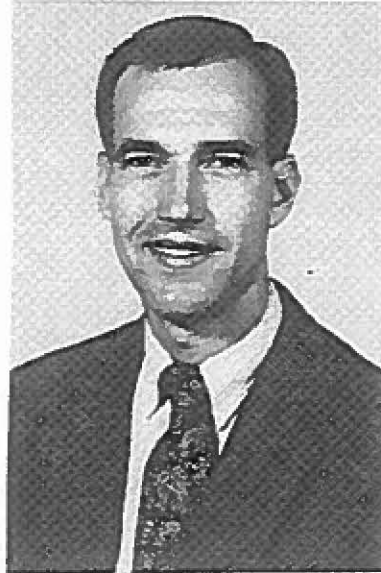

RESUME OF ALLAN C. POLLEY

Allan Polley, Major, U. S. Marine Corps, was born in Swindon, England in 1957. He graduated from Texas Tech University, receiving the degree Bachelor of Arts in Economics in 1979. He also attended the Naval Postgraduate School, where he earned the degree Master of Science in Management (Defense Systems Analysis) in 1990.



Major Polley has served as an F-4 Radar Intercept Officer for seven years, attending the Naval Fighter Weapons School and Weapons and Tactics Instructors Course.
