RESUME OF ROBERT RICHARD READ

Robert Read was born in Columbus, Ohio on 5 October 1929. He attended The Ohio State University where he majored in mathematics and received the B.S. degree in 1951.

Graduate study followed at the University of California at Berkeley, where he received a Ph.D. in mathematical statistics in September 1957. His research was done under the direction of Professor Jerzy Neyman in the area of probabilistic model building.

Following graduation, he joined the University of California's Institute of Engineering Research and later the Institute of Transportation and Traffic Engineering where he served in a variety of research and teaching capacities. For the academic year 1960-61, he served as a visiting Assistant Professor in the Statistics Department at the University of Chicago.

In September 1961, he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, as an Associate Professor in the Department of Mathematics. From 1971 to the present he has been Professor of Probability, Statistics, and Operations Research.

He is a member of the Institute of Mathematical Statistics, the Society of Sigma Xi, and the American Association of University Professors.
