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RESUME OF JACOB BERTRAM WICKHAM

Jacob B. Wickham was born in Newark, New Jersey, in 1919. He attended the University of California at Los Angeles until entering military service in 1941.

He served in the Army Air Force as a weather forecaster until 1945, then resumed study at the University of California at Berkely, majoring in civil engineering. He received the Bachelor of Science degree in 1947.

He then studied oceanography at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography at La Jolla, California, and received the degree of Master of Science in 1949.

During 1950 he did research on time changes in sea ice at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

In August, 1951, he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School as Assistant Professor in the Department of Meteorology. He is currently Associate Professor in the Department of Oceanography.

His major research activity is in the description of the form and behavior of the California Countercurrent in the region offshore of Central California.

He is a member of the American Geophysical Union and served on the Pacific Southwest Regional Committee representing the Oceanography Section of the American Geophysical Union from 1959 until 1963.
