
RESUME OF LAWRENCE JAMES ZIOMEK

Lawrence Ziomek was born in Chicago, Illinois on August 8, 1949. He received the degrees of Bachelor of Engineering from Villanova University in 1971, Master of Science from the University of Rhode Island in 1974 and Ph.D. from The Pennsylvania State University in 1981.

From 1973-1976 he was a member of the technical staff of TRW Systems Group in Redondo Beach, CA. From Sept. 1976-April 1982 he was a research assistant in the Department of Ocean Technology, Applied Research Laboratory, The Pennsylvania State university. In May of 1982, Professor Ziomek joined the staff of the Naval Postgradute School as an Assistant Professor.

Professor Ziomek's research has been in the area of underwater acoustics. He has authored several technical papers in this area.
