RESUME OF MIKHAIL TSYPKIN

Born and raised in the Soviet Union. Graduated from Moscow State University in 1973. Emigrated from the Soviet Union in 1977, and came to the US the same year. Attended Harvard University in 1978-1985. Received two degrees from Harvard: M.A. in Regional Studies--Soviet Union in 1980, and Ph.D. in Political Science in 1985. In 1985-1987 was the Salvatori Fellow in Soviet Studies at the Heritage Foundation in Washington, D.C. Served as a consultant to a number of private and governmental research institutions, including the Center for Naval Warfare at the Naval War College, and System Planning Corporation in Arlington, VA. Became a U.S. naturalized citizen in 1984.
