## RESUME OF ROBERT DONALD WALDO

Robert D. Waldo was born in Los Angeles, California, on 28 November 1925. He attended the University of Colorado at Boulder where he majored in aeronautical engineering. He received the degree of Bachelor of Science in June 1948 and the degree of Master of Science in June 1949.

In September 1961 he enrolled in the business economics program at Claremont Graduate School, Claremont, California. He received the degree of Master of Business Economics in June 1966. His research was in the area of the return of investment for government research and development. He received the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in June 1972. His research was in the field of urban economics and transportation.



He worked for North American Aviation until 1951 as an aerodynamacist. In 1951 he joined Aerojet General Corporation where he was employed until 1972. While at Aerojet he held the following positions: Manager of the Systems Design and Analysis Division; Manager of Operations Analysis, Nuclear Rocket Operations; Manager of Corporate Planning and Operations Research; Program Manager, and then Operations Manager of the Surface Effect Ships Division.

He has previously taught at the University of Colorado, the University of California at Los Angeles Extension School, and the Claremont Graduate School.

In July 1972 he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, where he is teaching in the Navy Management Systems Center.

He is a member of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics, the Highway Research Board, and Pi Tau Sigma.
