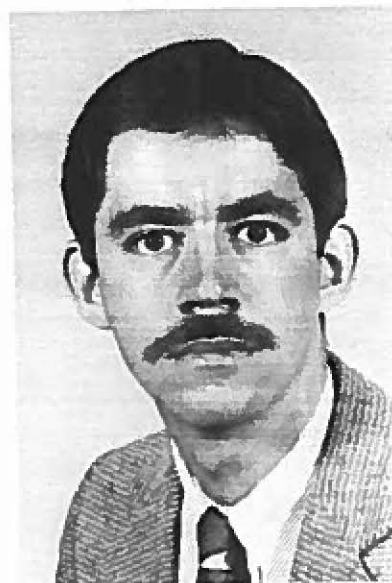

RESUME OF STEPHEN MICHAEL WILLIAMS

Stephen M. Williams was born August 11, 1963 in Independence, Missouri. In 1985, he received a B.S. in Electrical Engineering with honors. Subsequent to graduation, he was employed at Allied Signal Aerospace Corporation in Kansas City, Missouri as a test equipment engineer.



From 1987 to 1990, he worked as a research assistant at the Power Electronic Research Center. He received the M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Electrical Engineering from the University of Missouri-Columbia in 1988 and 1990, respectively. In 1990, he joined the faculty of the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the Naval Postgraduate School as an Assistant Professor. His research work is in the areas of power systems, power electronic converters, and controls implementation.
