RESUME OF CLYDE L. SCANDRETT

Clyde Scandrett was born in Winnipeg, Canada on March 24, 1954. He received his B.S. in 1976 from the California Institute of Technology and his Ph.D. in Engineering Sciences and Applied Mathematics from Northwestern University in 1985.

Professor Scandrett was a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at Northwestern University with J. D. Achenbach, Professor of Civil Engineering, as his research advisor. He was also an Assistant Research at the Supercomputer Computations Research Institute at Florida State Univ.

He joined the Mathematics Department of the Naval Postgraduate School in September of 1987 where he is an Assistant Professor.

Professor Scandrett's research interests include several sub-fields of mathematics: wave propagation, partial differential equations, elasticity, fluid mechanics, and scientific computations of partial differential equations. He is a member of SIAM and Sigma Xi.
