RESUME OF ALAN ROBERT WASHBURN

Alan R. Washburn was born in Pittsburg, Pennsylvania, in 1940. He attended Carnegie Institute of Technology from 1958 until 1965, receiving a Ph.D. in electrical engineering in the Systems and Communications Science Program in June 1965. His research in the field of discrete analytic function theory was under the direction of Professor Richard J. Duffin.

He received a Westinghouse Scholarship for his undergraduate work, and a National Science Foundation Fellowship for his post-graduate work.

From 1965 to 1968 he was employed in the Missile and Information Systems Division of the Boeing Company in Kent, Washington. He then was associated with Industrial Engineering at the Commercial Airplane Group of the Boeing Company in Renton, Washington.

In 1970 he joined the faculty of the Naval Postgraduate School at Monterey, California, where he teaches in the Operations Research Department.

He is a member of the Operations Research Society, Phi Kappa Phi, Eta Kappa Nu, Tau Delta Pi, Omicron Delta Kappa, and Pi Delta Epsilon.
