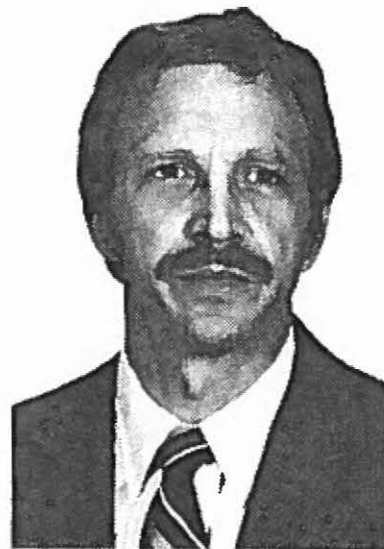

## RESUME OF ALAN ROBERT WASHBURN

Alan Washburn was born in 1940 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He stayed in Pittsburgh until 1965, when he was graduated from Carnegie Mellon University with a PhD in Electrical Engineering.

After graduating from CMU, he took employment as an engineer at the Boeing Company. He remained at Boeing for five years, working on military systems design problems for three years and then in the Commercial Airplane Division for two years. In 1970 he left Boeing to join the Operations Research Department at the Naval Postgraduate School as an Assistant Professor. He remains at NPS, currently holds the rank of Professor, and has served as department chairman and Associate Dean of Faculty.



His publications are mainly in the area of Probability, particularly Two Person Zero Sum Games and Search Theory. He also maintains an interest in Optimization. Military application areas include Search and Surveillance, Antisubmarine Warfare, and Mine Warfare.

He is an active member of the Operations Research Society of America.

His only bad habit is the smoking of an occasional cigar.
