## Congressman Farr, New NPS President To Dedicate Academic Building

Rep. Sam Farr (D-Carmel) and retired Vice Admiral Dan Oliver, the new Naval Postgraduate School president, will be the keynote speakers for a dedication ceremony of the Glasgow Hall annex. The ribbon cutting will be held Monday, April 9, at 2 p.m. in the building's outdoor courtyard.

The annex is a \$12 million project which adds 32,000 square feet and state-of-the-art information technology for the computer science department and interdisciplinary Cebrowski Institute for Innovation and Information Superiority, both units of the Graduate School of Operational and Information Sciences (GSOIS).

The facility was designed to be compatible with the existing Glasgow Hall, a 108,000 square-foot building completed in 1992. The original building has 19 classrooms, 150 offices, laboratories, study rooms, a lecture hall and an auditorium. The Glasgow Hall annex provides 90 additional rooms for high tech-labs and offices.

The dedication ceremony will mark Oliver's first media event as NPS president on his first day in office. He is the institution's first permanent civilian president and was appointed to a five-year term by Secretary of the Navy Donald Winter.
