Vice Admiral David E. Frost, USN (Retired) **Frost & Associates, Inc.**

Vice Admiral David E. Frost (retired) is President of Frost & Associates, a private consulting firm in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Admiral Frost retired in 1996 after 33 years of active service in the United States Navy. His final military assignment was Deputy Commander, United States Space Command and Vice Commander, NORAD. In earlier tours he served as the Director of Operations at U.S. European Command, Commander of Carrier Group Eight, Commander of Naval Space Command, Captain of two ships including the aircraft carrier *SARATOGA*, Commander of two fighter squadrons, and Commander of Navy Fighter Weapons School (TOPGUN).

Frost & Associates specializes in the fields of missile defense, space systems, C4ISR systems, and military operational concepts. The company also designs and conducts operational wargames for senior decision seminars. In addition to his work with industry, Admiral Frost is a consultant to the Defense Science Board, the Air Force Scientific Advisory Board, and a member of advisory panels at U.S. Strategic Command, Air Force Space Command and other Department of Defense organizations. He is on the Board of Directors for Photon Research Associates, a technology company in San Diego. He is also a member of the Colorado Thirty Group.

Admiral Frost graduated from the United States Naval Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree. He completed the Harvard program for Senior Executives in National

and International Security and the Harvard Defense Policy Seminar. While on active duty he receive numerous military decorations including the Defense Distinguished Service Award, the Defenses Superior Service Award, and four Legion of Merit Awards.
