MISSION

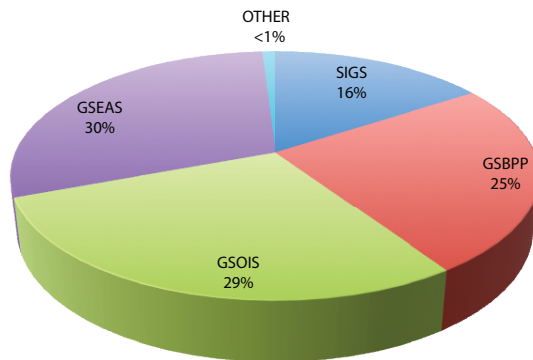

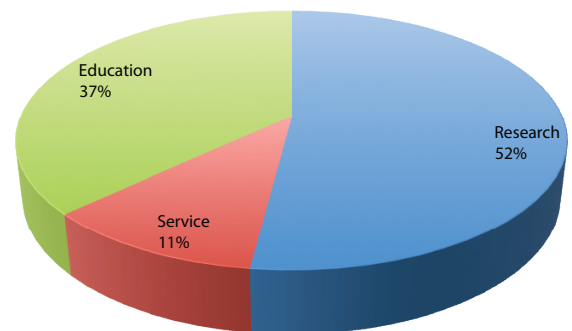
