## RESUME OF JERRY LEE McCaffery

Jerry L. McCaffery was born October 1936 in Stoughton, Wisconsin. He attended the University of Wisconsin and received a Bachelor of Science degree in 1959 with majors in English and History. His graduate work was done in political science and public administration at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, where he received his Master's degree in 1969 and his Ph.D. in 1972.

He taught public budgeting at the University of Georgia from 1972 to 1975 and Indiana University from 1975 to 1984 when he moved to Monterey and the Naval Postgraduate School.

He has also spent seven years as a budget and management analyst with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue in various staff positions from 1964 to 1972.

His major research interest involves budget innovation and reform. He has published numerous articles on budget innovations, retrenchment budget systems, and teaching strategies for public budgeting. He presently is researching the Department of Navy planning-programming-budgeting system.

He has an active interest in the American Society for Public Administration and serves as Vice-President for the Monterey Bay Area Chapter for 1985-1986.
