RESUME OF GLEN ALAN MYERS

Glen Myers was born in Carrington, North Dakota in 1934. He attended the University of North Dakota and received the Bachelor of Science Degree in 1955; the M.S. Degree from Stanford in 1956; and the Ph.D. from Stanford in 1965. All degrees were in electrical engineering.

He is engaged in research in addition to normal teaching duties. His main interest has been in communication systems and receiving systems.

Prior to joining the Postgraduate School, he had six years industrial experience, plus two and a half years as a Research Assistant at Stanford University.

He joined the faculty of the Department of Electrical Engineering as an Associate Professor in January 1965.

Prof. Myers is a member of the American Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers and a member of Sigma Xi and Eta Kappa Nu.
