DISTINGUISHED PROFESSOR AWARD

1. **Background**

- a. Award was first presented in 1962.
- b. Awardee receives a silver medallion on a neck ribbon and a framed citation.
- c. If awardee desires, an inscription is made on the back of the medallion after presentation.
- d. The award may be presented annually should a qualified Naval Postgraduate School professor be selected.

2. **Action**

- a. The responsible action officer is the Provost (Code 01).
- b. The Faculty Selection Committee recommends candidates to the Superintendent via the Provost.
- c. The committee is composed of faculty members appointed by the Provost.
- d. This award is based on the recipient's scholarly accomplishments and recognition in his/her field and their impact on the educational programs of the School.
- e. The committee normally meets during the Spring Quarter.
