13. The only courses presented are EE-871, 872, 873, 874. These courses represent a year's work in electrical machine design. There are four hours of lecture and calculation per week for one group of students. There is no laboratory work.
14. The administration of the department (21 faculty and 10 electricians and enlisted men) requires much time and effort. In addition, membership on the Academic Council and on various committees requires further time. These additional duties demand at least thirty hours per week.
